  - Marshfield extended to 12 months
  - We agree the current delay in Pembroke is not sufficient to protect historic properties and allow enough time for alternatives to be investigated (such as moving a house, etc)
  - would need to change the bylaw, goes to bylaw committee -> select board -> town meeting
